The **Convention Registration Form** is now posted at <u>https://utahdiocesanconvention.org/</u> Congregations are asked to register <u>everyone</u> individually from their congregation by utilizing this form including all Members of the Clergy, Senior/Bishop's Wardens, Junior Wardens, Delegates, Alternates, Members of Standing Committee and Diocesan Council, Visitors, and Volunteers. The form can also be submitted by individuals if preferred.

The registration deadline is <u>March 4, 2022.</u> Delegation Certification Forms with all registered attendees will be sent to the clergy-in-charge of each congregation for signature per the diocesan Canons. This form must be returned to the diocesan offices by <u>March 11, 2022</u>.

The \$65 Registration fee for Convention covers meals, snacks, materials, and other associated costs.

The Holy Eucharist will be celebrated with the Bishop preaching at 9:00 am on Saturday, April 30, 2022.

Attendees are responsible for making their own hotel reservations. A discounted room rate of \$92.00 + tax (single/double rate) or \$99.00 + tax (triple/quad rate) per room has been established at the Plaza Hotel, 122 West South Temple, SLC, Utah 84101, 800-366-3684 / 801-521-0130. The cutoff date to receive this rate is March 28, 2022. Please let them know you are with the Episcopal Diocese of Utah when making reservations. All reservations must be guaranteed with a credit card or 1st night deposit. Individuals must cancel their reservation at least 72 hours prior to the first day of arrival to avoid one night's room charge. Parking is \$10.00 per day and \$10.00 per day rollaway fee.
